

Lake Meunier Rules & Regulations

Please make sure your entire party know our rules.



We reserve the right to check your tackle/rigs/set up at any time.

*Fish welfare is paramount! (see our fish handling & weighing guidelines)

- Please play the fish out and do not bully them. If you are an experienced angler of big carp you will know when they are ready. Please don't be shy to ask our bailiff or ourselves for advice on this or any aspect of the rules and the fishing.
- Our rules are there for the safety of the carp at all times, and our aim is to maintain a high standard of stunning fish in pristine condition for you to come and catch again in future years when they are even bigger.
- All fish are to be unhooked and photographed in the water (due to the safety of these stunning big fish, they must be unhooked, weighed and photographed as quickly as possible, using only one camera & not various cameras – please see our guidelines on fish handling and weighing).
- Have a bucket of water ready at all times to put on the fish whilst taking photos and fish must be put back into the water as quickly as possible.
- Unhooking mats, nets and weigh slings are provided and their use is compulsory. Please make sure they are wet before using them on the fish and keep out of sun.
- You must hold fish low to mat and photo one side only please.
- Never stand the fish up on its belly
- Please remove any watches/bracelets (or any items which may cause damage to the fish)
- Fish must be rested in weigh sling before release.

General

- Maximum 3 rods per angler
- Minimum of 15lb breaking strain main line.
- No lead core
- No Pellets

- Tiger nuts and peanuts are not to be used as throw out or hooked baits.
- Hemp will be allowed but only as part of a mix not on its own
- Please use strong wide gape or curve shank pattern hooks between size 6 & 8 only. We advise you use known brand names hooks
- No bent hook rigs or old style 360 hooks. If unsure drop us a line or call.
- *(Please speak with us if you have any questions re hooks or any of the rules)
- Forceps and antiseptic cream must be kept close by at all times.
- Please use antiseptic cream after every catch.
- Never leave your rods unattended.
- No swimming in the lake
- All nets, slings, cradles, mats are supplied. Do not bring nets, slings, cradles, mats onto the venue please. * please treat fish and your environment with the utmost care and respect at all times *
- We reserve the right to change the rules at any time.
- No Smoking in the house – please do not smoke in the house

Safety

Please take extra care when consuming alcohol and fishing. Life jackets are not supplied but must be used at all times when using the boat. Children are not allowed into the boat unattended by a parent or responsible adult and any use of the boat is at the users own risk.

Children

Children must be supervised at all times and your personal safety should be a priority at all times! You are on a fishing venue and obviously you and your loved ones are near deep water so please take care and act responsibly near and around the waterside.
